Ties can also be purchased from Student Reception before school, break or lunchtime.

Upon returning to the academy after the Christmas holidays there will be regular checks to ensure that all students are meeting our expectations.

Any students not wearing appropriate school dress will be given the option to change into correct uniform by borrowing from existing school stock which will be updated over Christmas; we hope that students will accept this kind gesture to avoid any further consequences.

I would also like to remind everyone that we operate a water only policy in lessons. We encourage students to bring their own clear water bottle with a sports cap and use the water fountains around the academy to fill up before lessons, at break or at lunch time only. Drinks that are bought from the canteen are to be consumed during break and lunch time only. As such any drinks brought into the academy such as energy drinks and fizzy pop will be confiscated and returned to students after school.

Finally, we have a 'no chewing gum' policy in school.
